

Bowie Nature Park Shelter Reservation Form

Any event that is open to the public and sponsored by a civic group, club or organization to include fundraisers must obtain a park use permit.

No refunds are given on shelter rentals.

Shelter #1 - is located on the west side of Lake Van closest to the restrooms and has one large grill. There is access to electricity for a \$10 fee. Can be rented Sunrise-Sunset, Sunrise-2:00pm, or 2:00pm-Sunset. Can hold up to 56 people.

Shelter #2 - is located on the east side of Lake Van and has two small grills. There is no electricity available. Can be rented Sunrise-Sunset, Sunrise-2:00pm, or 2:00pm-Sunset. Can hold up to 40 people.

Rental Prices – Both shelters rent at \$20 for a half day for citizens inside Fairview, TN city limits and \$30 for citizens outside. A full day can be rented for \$40 for citizens inside Fairview, TN city limits and \$60 for citizens outside.

Shelter Guidelines:

- ❖ No Balloons, piñatas, or confetti.
- ❖ No alcoholic beverages on park property.
- ❖ No dumping or littering on Park property.
- ❖ You are required to clean up after your event.
- ❖ All pets must be on a leash or tether at all times.
- ❖ Vehicles are restricted to designated roads and designated parking areas only.
- ❖ The speed limit is 10 miles per hour on all roads in the park.
- ❖ No fireworks allowed on park property.
- ❖ No hunting or willfully killing, harming or trapping of animals allowed on park property.
- ❖ Disturbance of animal habitat is prohibited.
- ❖ No swimming allowed on park property.
- ❖ No boating allowed in park lakes without written permission from the Parks Department.
- ❖ No cutting, removing or harvesting of timber unless written permission from the city manager has been obtained.
- ❖ No fires except in designated areas equipped with fireplaces or grills unless a permit has been obtained from the park director.
- ❖ No excessive or malicious noise.
- ❖ Removal of trees, shrubs or other plants is prohibited.
- ❖ People wishing to fish must have a valid Tennessee Fishing license and abide by all Tennessee Wildlife Resource Agency regulations.
- ❖ Pick up and remove all discarded fishing line, discarded line can cause death and injury to wildlife.
- ❖ Do not feed the wildlife.
- ❖ Anyone renting a shelter must comply with section 11-901 – 11.915 of the Fairview Municipal Code, the rules and regulations governing the park, and that prior to leaving the site we understand the site and surrounding area must be cleaned to pass the site or facility inspection.
